NETWORK OVERVIEW

IBCM NETWORK

IBCM as the International Brethren Conference on Mission (IBCM) commenced in 1993 and has convened and coordinated global conferences (every 4 years). The work has expanded over the years with the advent of several regional and language based conferences and the development of the Brethren Training Network (BTN) which holds training conferences (every 4 years) and has itself produced regional gatherings of leaders and educators.

On March 19, 2019, the organisation "IBCM Network" (International Brethren Church & Mission Network) was created to provide an essential base to further connect and serve the 40,000+ churches and organisations in over 160 countries worldwide. IBCM Network is served by a board of trustees, a number of staff, volunteers, and representatives, as well as an International Advisory Group, and a Youth Advisory Committee.

IBCM9 GLOBAL CONFERENCE

The flagship event of IBCM Network is the global conference which gathers people every 4 years from over 160 countries where we are represented. These global events are designed to connect, unite, and encourage mission and ministry for the glory of God. IBCM8 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, gathered 1204 people from 104 countries.

Following the success of IBCM8 in 2023, IBCM Network decided to take the global conference to Africa. In September 2024 it was announced that IBCM9 would be hosted in Kigali, Rwanda. The preparation and organisational work for such a global conference is immense, it commenced in 2022 and will continue up to opening of the conference in June 2027.

GO-SERVE MISSION OPPORTUNITIES

Mission is at the heart of God. He sent his son into the world to show just how much he loved us. Today we are called to carry out the same task, to take the love of God into to the world to those who do not know his love for them. We are all called to "put love where love is not" through both word and action.

Mission therefore requires two things: understanding the love of God and his word (discipleship) and knowing how best to express his love in any context (skills).

By collaborating with mission partners, the Go-Serve network provides short-term international mission team opportunities in various countries worldwide that combine discipleship training and skills development to equip you to effectively serve God by putting love where love is not in different mission contexts. Go-Serve is:

GO-DISCIPLE NETWORK

One of the most common comments we hear from people and churches around the world is the need for discipleship. Evangelism is happening and people are coming to Christ they say, but what is really needed now is discipleship, to bring true life to the lives of others.

The Go-Disciple network is working on providing an intentional discipleship programme designed to be delivered in a transferable mentoring process to facilitate evangelism and the growth of believers. Currently 2 of the planned 10 tracks have been published with others in the writing and editing stages. The programme is available in print, online, and via the IBCM Network App. The completed tracks have been translated into a number of languages including:

Chinese | Polish | Khmer Romanian | Spanish | Italian.

GO-CARE NETWORK

The church is called to "build itself up in love" (Ephesians 4:16). Yet somehow in the frantic pace of church life the loving care of the heart is often overlooked. The Go-Care network is designed to create a network of people who can provide essential member care resources, pastoral care training, and soul-care guidance. The Go-Care network consists of a growing group of international group of pastoral carers and counselling specialists who are biblically trained.

In order to build a loving community of God's people, church members need to know how to care for others by being able to:

- listen attentively
- communicate effectively
- relate intentionally

The Go-Care network provides resources to enable members to care for one another with the love of Christ.

In order to guide the hearts of people toward transformation, pastoral carers need to know how to address various life issues from a biblical perspective. The Go-Care network provides pastoral carers with training resources, and other support networks, to enable them to care lovingly and effectively for their church community.

In this complex world our network of churches needs a trusted network of Christian Brethren specialist counsellors that members and carers can consult with confidence. The Go-Care network provides carers with an international team of specialists who can provide help in areas like: anger, fear and anxiety, self-harm, stress and depression, abuse, trauma, addiction, parenting and marriage.

BTN exists to grow a global network that facilitates bible-based spiritual training to produce and strengthen ministry and mission minded leaders in Brethren churches across the world.

Build a global network of discipleship, ministry, theology, counselling, and education trainers for encouragement, strengthening, partnership and collaboration.

Encourage Bible Schools and colleges to embrace a culture of excellence in training.

Build a network of teachers, scholars, and specialists that are engaged in international ministry.

Build a network of publishers and producers of training resources that encourages Brethren publications.

Encourage churches to embrace a culture of learning.

Through sending international teams of teachers and trainers, IBCM Network seeks to connect, encourage, and build up under resourced Christian leaders across the world. In many lands and contexts there exists neither opportunity nor ongoing support to ensure the continual strengthening of the churches that were planted. This leaves those people and churches open to becoming weak, and ineffective. Investing in leaders, specifically the younger, is one of the most effective ways of impacting an entire community for Christ. What is learned is readily passed on to all.

INTERNATIONAL TRAINING PROJECT

To provide and facilitate quality contextualised ministry training that is accessible, affordable, and accredited, to the majority world nations in our network.

In many places around the world the gospel has taken root and there are a growing number of churches. However, specifically in majority world countries, local Christians often lack access to pastoral, leadership, and Bible training, that is essential to ensure the growth, maturity, and future of the churches. In a number of countries there is the real threat that government legislation will close churches because pastors and leaders do not hold any form of accredited training. In response to this overwhelming need the Australian College of Christian Studies (ACCS) and IBCM Network are committed to provide and facilitate quality contextualised ministry training that is accessible, affordable, and accredited, to the majority world nations in our network.
