







**Neurotransmitters and Their Role** 

- Acetylcholine (ACh): plays a role in arousal, attention, memory, and motivation
- Dopamine: plays a role in motor disorders, such as Parkinson's disease
- Serotonin: affects emotions, arousal, and sleep

- "God may heal directly, through medicine, or in answer to prayer, as here. The oil is a symbol of the presence of God; it may also have been considered medicinal in James' day – Charles Ryrie, Ryrie Study Bible
- Scholars see this anointing as practical and medicinal. Its use here was clearly with the expectation that physical healing could occur." – David Nystrom, The NIV Application Commentary: James
- "The use of oil for medicinal purpose is referred to in Isa. 1:6; Mk. 6:13 and Lk. 10:34. We have here medicine and prayer." – Alexander Ross, NICNT: The Epistle of James & John





#### **Depression - Sin**

- Psalm 32:3-5 For when I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long.
  For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer. I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not cover my iniquity; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD," and you forgave the iniquity of my sin.
- Psalm 51 Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin!

#### **Depression – Sin?**

 John 9:2 – "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?"

 John 5:14 - Afterward Jesus found him in the temple and said to him, "See, you are well! Sin no more, that nothing worse may happen to you."

 John 8:11 - "Neither do I condemn you; go, and from now on sin no more."

#### **Depression - Situation**

- Job 1:20 Then Job arose and tore his robe and shaved his head and fell on the ground and worshiped. <sup>21</sup>And he said, "Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked shall I return. The LORD gave, and the LORD has taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD."
- Job's Friends (Eilphaz, Bildad, Zophar) Job 4:7,8 Remember: who that was innocent ever perished? Or where were the upright cut off? As I have seen, those who plow iniquity and sow trouble reap the same.

#### **Depression - Situation**

 Elihu – Job 32:1 – He burned with anger also at Job's three friends because they had found no answer, although they had declared Job to be in the wrong.

 Job 42:1 - Then Job answered the LORD and said: "I know that you can do all things, and that no purpose of yours can be thwarted.
